

Orphanage

Caring for children abandoned to poverty and desperation is an important ministry of our Bahay Kalinga Orphanage (House of Love) on the island of Mindoro, Philippines. Qualified orphans are prepared for adoption and many have found loving and caring homes in the Philippines and abroad.



Community Outreach

Our Learning Centers in the remote islands of the Philippines provide early childhood education and feeding programs. While our Boys and Girls Dormitory serves as a safe haven for young people desiring a high school education not available on their home island.

Many of the islanders are the "least" in the world of economic and political giants, often losing the battle on every side. PMA desires to assist them by providing livelihood programs that can support them, provide the needs of their families and give them dignity and honor.

PMF Churches

By establishing Pacific Mission Fellowship churches and working with existing local churches, PMA seeks to raise up a new generation for Christ. This is accomplished through Bible studies, discipleship, leadership training, prayer and worship services, children and youth activities and a variety of music and sports oriented outreach ministries.

Media Ministries

Making Jesus Christ known so that every island may hear is the mandate of our Media Ministry - living and spreading the Word of God. The Media Ministry on the island of Pohnpei, Federated States of Micronesia impacts the island states and surrounding outer islands through its Good News Press, Studio, FM and short-wave tropical band radio.



Locations

Micronesia covers a vast ocean area of over 3 million square miles, a region larger than the continental United States. The territory has a heterogeneous population of about 200,000 people scattered among more than 2,100 islands and atolls.

The **Philippines**, with over 7,100 islands and 80 million people, is a country of great contrast, intense beauty, and incredible misery. PMA ministers in this nation of islands. It is to the remotest of these islands that we have been called.

PMA at a Glance

The primary goal of Pacific Missionary Aviation is to glorify God, and make our Lord Jesus Christ known to the peoples of Micronesia and the Philippines. Aircraft and boats are utilized to bring the gospel to remote island peoples who might otherwise remain unreached.

God's love is made tangible to those we serve as we meet the needs of the total person - body, soul and spirit. Born out of love and compassion for the people of the islands and a desire to be obedient to the Lord's command, PMA provides free medical care, sea searches, rescue and disaster relief, transports medical and food supplies, and provides logistical help to the islands.

We plant churches, support existing island churches, operate an orphanage, youth dormitories and learning centers, media ministries and provide other services as indicated by the needs of the people we serve.

Aviation

Many islands served by PMA were previously accessible only by small outrigger canoe, and some remain that way to this day! High waves often make this form of travel very treacherous, rendering many of the small islands totally isolated for weeks on end. Air-drops of relief supplies immediately after a typhoon may be the atoll's only hope of survival. Often, we land on a nearby island, and still must travel an hour or two by outrigger canoe, navigating treacherous reefs, and often high waves, to reach some of the islands we serve! Our airplanes in Micronesia operate out of Yap, and in the Philippines out of Manila.

With irregular and often nonexistent transportation to the outside world, many of these people would live and die without the hope of adequate medical, educational and spiritual help. Though small in number, they are equally important to God.

Passenger and cargo services, transport of food and supplies, disaster relief, medical evacuations and sea searches are just the beginning of the many ways in which Christ's love reaches those in need.

Sea Haven

Our floating clinic, the "M/V Sea Haven", serves remote islands that have no harbors or airstrips. Based in Pohnpei, the 189-ton Sea Haven serves among the atolls of the Federated States of Micronesia. The Sea Haven provides routine and emergency medical services, primary health care, health education, disaster relief and logistical support to outer-island dispensaries.

A welcome and important ministry to the island pastors and church leaders is the Biblical teaching the Sea Haven crew provides. Their goal is to develop Christian leaders and disciple men who can lead and grow established island churches.
