


## Orphanage

Caring for children abandoned to poverty and desperation is an important ministry of our Bahay Kalinga (House of Love) on the island of Mindoro, Philippines. Qualified orphans are readied for adoption and many have found loving and caring homes in the Philippines and abroad.



## Community Outreach

Our Learning Centers in the remote islands of the Philippines provide early childhood education and feeding programs. Dormitory ministry serves as a safe haven for young people desiring a high school education not available on their home island.

Many of the islanders are the “least” in the world of economic and political giants, often losing the battle on every side. PMA desires to assist them by providing livelihood programs that can support them, provide the needs of their families and give them dignity and honor.

The Media Ministry on the island of Pohnpei, Federated States of Micronesia, impacts the island states and surrounding outer islands through its printing shop, studio, FM and shortwave tropical band radio.



## Locations

**Micronesia** covers a vast ocean area of over 3 million square miles, a region larger than the continental United States. The territory has a heterogeneous population of about 400,000 people scattered among more than 2,100 islands and atolls.

The **Philippines**, with over 7,100 islands and 90 million people, is a country of great contrast, intense beauty, and incredible poverty. PMA ministers in this nation of islands. It is to the remotest of these islands that we have been called.

## PMA at a Glance

The idyllic setting in the remote islands of Micronesia and the Philippines belie the deep needs the people have. Many live in isolated, almost impossible to reach outer islands, often the hardest hit by typhoons and other natural calamities. This is where Pacific Mission Aviation serves, bringing hope and changing lives, where few organizations have chosen to offer assistance or share the Word of God.

God’s love is made tangible to those we serve as we meet the needs of the total person: body, soul and spirit. Through our aircraft and medical ship, PMA provides search & rescue operations, disaster relief, bring food, medical, educational, logistical and spiritual help to the islands. Community services like an orphanage, medical missions, learning centers, youth dormitory, livelihood projects are many ways PMA provides practical help to the island communities.

The heart of all these is the PMF church where we love all people, build the body of Christ and disciple the faithful.

## Aviation

Many islands served by PMA were previously accessible only by small outrigger canoe, and some remain that way to this day! High seas often make this form of travel very challenging, rendering many of the small islands totally isolated for weeks on end. Airdrops of relief supplies immediately after a typhoon may be the islander's only hope for survival. Often, we land on a nearby island, and still must travel an hour or two by outrigger canoe, navigating treacherous reefs, and often turbulent waves, to reach some of the islands we serve! Our airplanes in Micronesia operate out of Yap and Palau, and in the Philippines out of Manila.

With irregular and often nonexistent transportation to the outside world, many of these people would live and die without the hope of adequate medical, educational and spiritual help. Though small in number, they are equally important to God.

Passenger and cargo services, transport of food and supplies, disaster relief, medical evacuations and search & rescue are just the beginning of the many ways in which Christ's love reaches those in need.

## Sea Haven

Based in Pohnpei, our floating clinic, the 189-ton "M/V Sea Haven" serves remote islands that have no harbors or airstrips. The Sea Haven provides routine and emergency medical services, primary health care, health education, disaster relief and logistical support to outer-island dispensaries.

A welcome and important ministry to the island pastors and church leaders is the Biblical teaching the Sea Haven crew provides. Their goal is to develop Christian leaders and disciple men who can lead and grow established island churches.
