**Dear Praying Friends and Faithful Partners,** 

"I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living! Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!" Psalms 27:13-14

In Guam, we are now on our 6<sup>th</sup> month semi-lockdown. People here have really been very conscious of protecting others and themselves by following the protocols for Covid prevention. However, many say they find it tiring and stressful. Why? A simple errand needs to be planned and there is the anxiety attached to going out that one may contract the virus. How long must we wait until we are back to normal? No one knows the answer to this. Waiting is truly difficult. In the life of Joseph from the Old Testament, we read about his experience, from being sold by his own brothers to be a slave, from slave to being promoted in Potiphar's household, then being wrongly accused by Potiphar's wife, then thrown into prison, then promoted to be second only to Pharaoh – this process took a very long while! He was 17 years old when he was sold as a slave and was 30 years old when he took over the responsibility Pharaoh gave him. But we never see him complain to God. Through waiting, we see the character of Joseph revealed – how he responds to unpleasant things in his life and how he always gave glory to God. Because of the faithfulness of Joseph, and his ability to persevere under trial, not only was Egypt saved, but also the rest of the known world. His time of waiting resulted in the blessing of others, even those who had sinned against him.

We praise God for the willingness and availability of the Civic Action Team (CAT) doctor to respond to medical emergency flights, especially nowadays that the hospital is currently stretched thin. Since the CAT Doctor is only few minutes away from the Airport, the response time would be shortened significantly and thus will increase chances of survival of patients on worst case scenarios.
