Dear Friends: Christmas 2022

This week we get are getting ready for the Operation Christmas Child presentation in our church. We are looking forward to sharing God's greatest gift of salvation with several hundred children, ages 2-14. Each child will receive a shoebox gift and booklet at the end of the evangelistic event to tangibly illustrate the truth that Jesus is the greatest gift we could ever receive.

One of the songs we will be singing with the children says, "It's not just about the manger where the baby lay. It's not all about the angels who sang for him that day. It's not just about the shepherds or the bright and shining star. It's not all about the wise men who travelled from afar. It's about the cross, It's about my sin, It's about how Jesus came to be born once so that we could be born again. It's about the stone that was rolled away. So that you and I could have real life someday. It's about the cross!"

The true message of Christmas is that eternal God came to earth in the form of man in order to save His own creation. Those infant hands that moved about in the wooden manger were the very same hands that were later nailed to a rugged, wooden cross. On behalf of our entire mission family from Micronesia to the Philippines, I want to express our appreciation for your faithful prayer hands and hands that lovingly share financial support. Every time we medivac a patient from the islands, bathe a baby in our orphanage, hold a church service, teach children to love God's Word, preach the Word from an island pulpit, broadcast Christian music and teaching over our radio station, fit an islander with reading glasses, baptize a new believer...it is because you are praying with us to be faithful to the Cross.

When you come across a manger scene, notice the baby, but think beyond Christ's infancy to His amazing reason for coming. Make an effort to remember the real message of Christmas. Remember His hands. Remember His heart. Remember His undying love for you. Remember the beautiful Cross!
