As we continue to serve the island of Angaur with flights, Bible studies, and on-call medevac services, it gives us great joy to hear from the Angaur people how thankful they are that PMA is here, making a difference. When we get positive feedback like this we assure them, we do this because of the great love that Jesus Christ has for us.
